

Answering with an announcement when you can't take calls right away

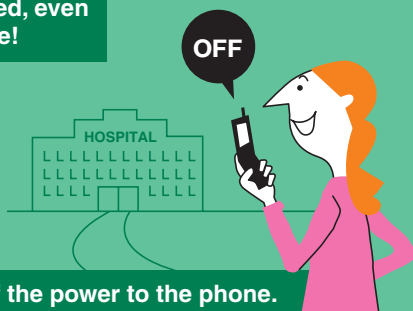

If an incoming call comes while driving or in a public facility or other location where mobile phones should not be used, an announcement informs the caller that the call must be made later. This provides you with assurance when you are required to turn off your mobile phone or need to wait to answer calls.

Uses:



Rest assured, even as you drive!



You can also turn off the power to the phone.

«(Service Features)»

Use different ways for different needs!

Set your mobile phone to Public Mode (Drive Mode) when driving or in other situations where you need to wait to take calls; when in areas where, because of concerns about the effects of radio signal, you must turn off your mobile phone, use the Phone OFF setting.

The incoming call is not connected.

Announcement is played to callers, explaining that the call is being refused, and no notification of the incoming call (e.g. with a ring tone, vibration, or light) is made.

[With smartphones (only models running AndroidOS)]

Use the following procedure to make the settings. *Procedures may differ depending on handset.

● From the Handset Screen

Select "Settings." → Select "Call settings." → Select "Network service." → Select "Public mode (power OFF) settings."

*For certain models without a menu, make settings using the dial pad.

*Only the Public Mode (Phone OFF) setting can be used. The Public Mode (Drive Mode) setting is not available.

Activating and Deactivating Public Mode (Drive Mode)

- The announcement answers, "The person you are calling is currently driving or in an area where cellphones should not be used. Please try again later."

Using the Dial Pad

Activate



(Car icon button)

Hold down until "Public (Drive) mode /Set"* is displayed.

*With certain models, the message "Driving Mode/Set" appear.

*Cannot be set with the SIMPURE L and smartphones.

*Procedures for handsets not featuring the above button may differ according to the model; refer to the user's manual for details.

Deactivate



(Car icon button)

Hold down until "Public (Drive) mode /Reset"* is displayed.

*With certain models, the message "Driving Mode/Reset" appear.

Activating and Deactivating Public Mode (Phone OFF)

Make the setting in advance using the dial pad.

- The announcement answers, "The person you are calling is currently in an area where use is prohibited. Please try again later."

Using the Dial Pad

Activate



1

Press

Announcement

"The service is now activated. If you receive a call when your phone is outside the service area or is turned off, the caller will hear a guidance message."

2 Press to finish.

Deactivate



1

Press

Announcement

"The service is now deactivated."

2 Press to finish.

* The announcements may differ depending on the settings.



One-Point Advice

How do I check the Public Mode (Phone OFF) status?

Press ***25259** with the dial pad to access the guidance announcement; your settings will be read out.

Charges for Settings **No dialing charges apply for "Activation" or "Deactivation" and similar operations.**

Notes on Use

- Relationship between incoming calls received when the Public Mode (Drive Mode·Phone OFF) is set to activate and other services.

Service name	Incoming call handling
Voice Mail Service	After the Public Mode (Drive Mode·Phone OFF) announcement is played, the message is taken.
Call Forwarding Service	After the Public Mode (Drive Mode·Phone OFF) announcement is played, the call is transferred to the forwarding number.
Call Waiting Service	The Public Mode (Drive Mode) announcement is played. *Not compatible with Public Mode (Phone OFF).
Nuisance Call Blocking Service	If the caller's number is on the Call Blocking list, the Nuisance Call Blocking announcement is played.
Caller ID Display Request Service	If the caller has blocked Caller ID, an announcement will be played requesting the caller to allow Caller ID, and then the call will be terminated.

- If an incoming call is received while the Public Mode (Drive Mode) setting is being set, the call remains in the incoming call history.
- When incoming calls are received with a Videophone, the Public Mode announcement is played in graphic format.
- Some models can be set to sound the special Area Mail ring tone when an Early Warning "Area Mail" is received even if the handset is set to Public Mode (Drive Mode). At the time of purchase, the handset is set so that the ring tone is played even while Public Mode (Drive Mode) is activated. The setting can be changed so that the ring tone does not sound.
- This service may not be available on some handsets.
